Dear Sarkar,

We are pleased that you will begin your master's program at the Hebrew University's International Graduate Bio-Medical Sciences Program this October 2021. Please note you are required to complete 28 credits for your two year M.Sc degree.

Depending on academic progress you will be entitled to a 200% scholarship from the international program which is approximately 3,580 NIS per month and if agreed upon an additional sum from your mentor. This will be given to you as monthly scholarship for 24 months. The program will also help you with rent for up to NIS 900 per month upon proof of a contract in your name.

You have received a private room in a dormitory apartment with two other female students in the student village on the Mt. Scopus campus of the Hebrew University for the entire year. To help you with the bureaucracy we will now pay for the first three months and you will refund us later.
